Appearance

- 2 Wearing proper referee's kit
- 1 Wearing non-referee's outfit or a referee's outfit causing problems for players due to its colour.
- 0 Not in proper kit, e.g. wearing tracksuit or shirt and trousers

Communication

- 3 Decisions were indicated by the good use of the whistle, a clear direction signal and mostly confirmed by the use of official signals. When advantage was played this was clearly indicated (by use of the voice or a clear signal).
- 2 Decisions were indicated by the good use of the whistle, a direction signal and mostly confirmed by the use of official signals. However, advantage was not always indicated (by use of the voice or by a signal).
- 1 It was frequently unclear to whom the decision had been given or what offence had been committed.
- 0 Often hesitant or poor use of the whistle (e.g. often not loud enough to be heard) and proper signals rarely used.

Consistency of decisions

- 3 Similar offences appeared to be nearly always punished (making allowance for advantage when played).
- 2 One or two types of offence did not always appear to be punished in a consistent manner.
- 1 Inconsistent punishment for several types of similar offences (including apparent inconsistency between teams)
- 0 Very inconsistent punishment for several types of offence (*please give details overleaf*).

Application of the rules

- 4 No problems with the referee's application of the rules.
- 3 Only one or two problems with the referee's application of the rules. (*please give details overleaf*)
- 1 Several problems with the referee's application of the rules. (*please give details overleaf*)

Playing Advantage

- 3 Advantage was applied in appropriate situations.
- 2 Insufficient opportunity was taken to play advantage for light infringements.
- 0 Far too much advantage was played when heavy contact was involved.

Control of over-physical play

- 4 Most contact was acknowledged as having been seen by either giving a free pass (or penalty) or by giving a clear indication of advantage using a signal or by voice.
- 3 Most contact appeared to have been seen but insufficient repeat infringement penalties given.
- 2 Most heavy contact was punished but quite a lot of light contact took place that was not acknowledged as having been seen (i.e. no whistle or signal for advantage)
- 1 Insufficient contact was penalised or acknowledged as having been seen.
- 0 Heavy contact appeared to be ignored leading to a very rough game.

Positioning

- 3 Was mostly in a good position to judge offences. Position was varied according to the needs of the game.
- 2 Was generally up with play but positioning was not varied enough according to the needs of the game.
- 1 Was often too far from the action, rarely taking a position near the post.
- 0 Was mostly far too remote from the action thereby missing many offences.

Overall control

- 8 Controlled the game very well and appeared to have the confidence of the players.
- 6 Controlled the game quite well. Any obvious cases of dissent were dealt with to minimise their effect on the match.
- 4 Overall control was satisfactory. Dissent, where it occurred, was kept to a minimum.
- 2 Did not earn the confidence of the players. Allowed too much dissent to occur and/or too many decisions appeared to be influenced by players' appeals.
- 0 Match was out of control.
